



Virtual Attendance Requirements for the Accredited Buyer Representative (ABR) Designation Course

To complete the designation coursework and earn MA Continuing Education credit, **you must attend all 3 classes in their entirety, no exceptions!** Please note that make-up dates are not available, if you are unable to commit to the 3 days, please do not register.

When attending Greater Boston Association of REALTORS® (GBAR) virtual courses, you MUST:

- attend with your camera on and always remain visible
- be indoors
- remain stationary and keep your camera stationary
- not be driving or riding in a vehicle
- be on time and remain for the entirety of the class.

Tips for attending a GBAR Virtual course:

We want to make the experience of attending a virtual course the same as if you were in a physical classroom. Please minimize distractions and be present. Do not take or make calls or texts, converse with others at your location, or engage in any other activities in your home/office (e.g., cooking, exercising, laundry, etc.). At the beginning of the class, the instructor/GBAR Staff will address the protocol for stepping away from the camera, if necessary, for 1-2 minutes during the course.
